EVALUATION:

COMPLETED PROJECTS

60% Set for the foundation course, variable for studio in terms two and three. Percentage varies slightly per term.

SERVICE

5% Students are required to deliver one day of service per term. One service mark is granted per 15 min. of service and so can be divided.. Only two students can serve a day. Marks may be withheld if service is deemed unsatisfactory.

DEMERITS

10% Students are granted 10 marks per term. $\frac{1}{2}$ a mark is deducted without notice per incidence of: lates, swearing, unsafe behaviour, disruption of class, disruption of demonstration, off task behaviour, unduly out of assigned seating, excessive talking, neglecting clean-up, not respecting the classroom, tools, students and instructor.
